THE WOLF

The wolf is a mammal. It is related to the domestic dog. Wolves live in groups called packs. A big male wolf is the leader of the pack.

Wolves make a noise called a howl. Wolves howl to talk to each other. Sometimes they howl because they feel like it.

Many people are afraid of wolves.

In fact they are very gentle.

Wolves hunt an eat elks, reindeers and roe-deers. If wolves can't find prey, they sometimes attack sheep and cows.
