Each zebra has a unique pattern of stripes.

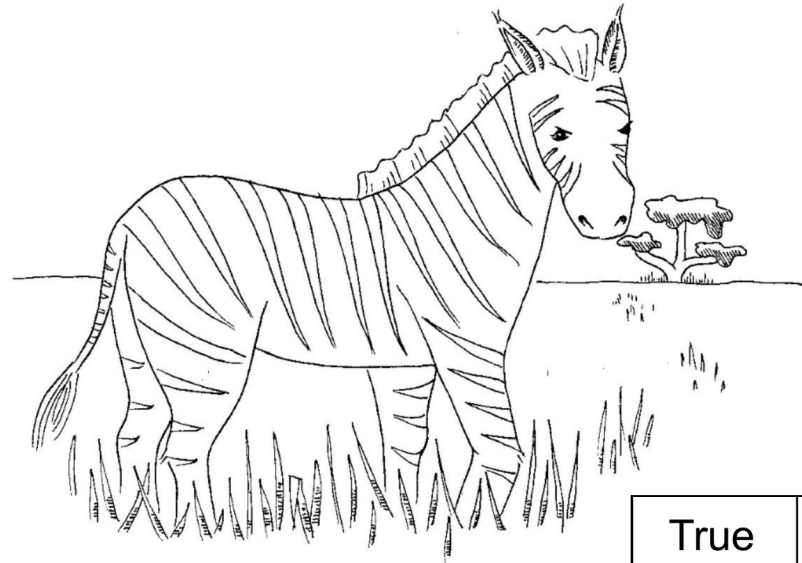
Zebras live in families with one male and lots of females. The babies are called foals.
